

Lichfield Festival Market FAQs

When is the Lichfield Festival Market?

The Market takes place around Lichfield Cathedral Close on the first Saturday of the July Festival. The next market will happen on Saturday 7th July 2012.

How long does it run for?

One day only – 10am-4pm.

What does it involve?

Each year we welcome over 120 stallholders who offer handcrafted gifts, homemade food, games and activities to the thousands of visitors who attend. We also offer a full programme of music and entertainment by local artists, children's activities, refreshment stands etc.

Can I book a stall?

We hire out pitches to stallholders selling handmade crafts, homemade food produce and to some local charities. Please note we do not accept 'car boot' or jumble stalls, general trade stands for shop-bought/imported goods.

How much does it cost?

A basic stall pitch costs £60 (£50 for Registered local charities).

How do I book?

Download a booking form from the website and return it to the Festival Office along with payment for your stall. Booking opens in October each year and we advise booking as early as possible. Our stalls usually sell out by February.

Can I choose my stall pitch?

Wherever possible we try to allocate you a pitch in the area that you would like to stand, but we cannot always guarantee spaces. We recommend contacting us early if you would like a specific pitch.

Do you provide a market stall?

No. We provide a pitch only. You will need to bring tables, chairs and a garden gazebo.

Do you have any indoor stalls?

No. All of our stalls are outside.
